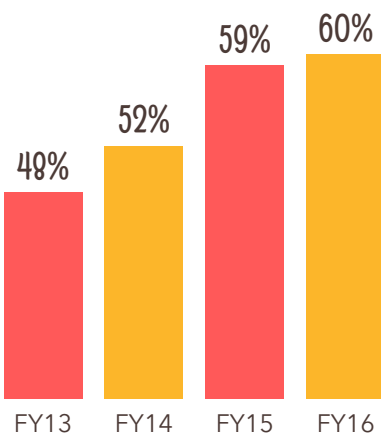


COMMUNITY IMPACT

304 clients and their family members were served in our counseling program

including **67** children who experienced a one-on-one relationship with a caring adult counselor

94% of counseling clients reported progress on the problem that initially brought them to counseling

4,845 units of service completed (defined as counseling sessions plus related case management hours)



1 senior needs assessment completed to identify and address additional community concerns



140 parents gathered monthly for discussion groups in an effort to raise emotionally healthy children



45 free weekly drop-in meditation sessions offered to the community



69 crisis calls answered around the clock by an FSG social worker alongside Glencoe Public Safety



29 individuals received direct financial assistance for utility bills, basic needs or transportation
