About Family Service of Glencoe: Rooted in Glencoe for more than 100 years, FSG is a community asset with a unique understanding of the northern suburbs. Our clinicians serve individuals, families, couples, children and adolescents. Glencoe is a village of approximately 8,000 people located on the Northshore of Chicago and on the Metra train line. Our work environment is professional, dynamic, innovative, and compassionate. FSG is fully integrated into the tight-knit community of Glencoe, which provides unique opportunities to engage in prevention, collaboration, and service delivery for clients and the community at large.

The 2nd year Clinical Intern will have the potential to work with children, youth, adults, couples, and families to address challenging social and emotional issues. Students will have the opportunity to learn to:

- Provide individual, couples, and/or family therapy utilizing an accepted clinical framework under supervision.
- Complete intake assessments, treatment plans, progress notes, and discharge summaries using our electronic medical record system.
- Provide client casework services to address clinical social service needs.
- Provide crisis follow up services in partnership with Glencoe Public Safety.
- Work collaboratively with community partners and FSG clinicians to plan and deliver education programs and events.
- Assess client risk of harm, provide appropriate safety planning, and complete required reporting.
- Adhere to professional standards of practice regarding clinical care and confidentiality.
- Bilingual Spanish students will have the opportunity to offer services in English or Spanish

The 2nd year Clinical Intern must be able to interact in a supportive and professional manner with clients, staff, board members and community. Interns operate as a member of our clinical team and participate in weekly individual and group supervision. The person in this position must work well in a small office team environment and be open to change as Family Service of Glencoe continues to adapt to the changing workplace recommendations from the pandemic. FSG is currently working in a hybrid model and will transition to primarily onsite as the public health conditions allow.

All clinicians and students are supervised by our Outreach and Intake Manager, Adriana (Alex) Ochoa, LCSW
